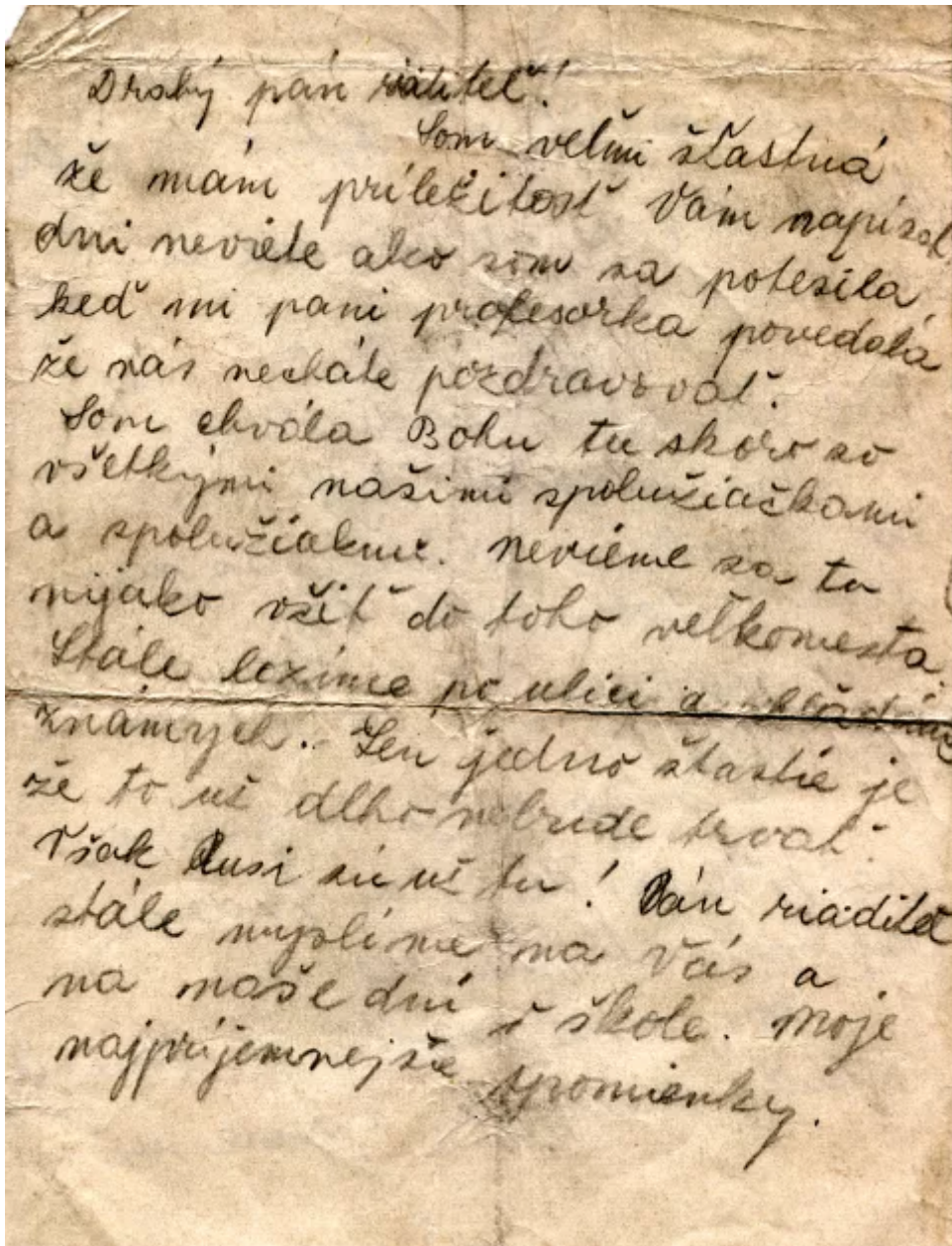


Letter From Alexander Bachnar's Students
