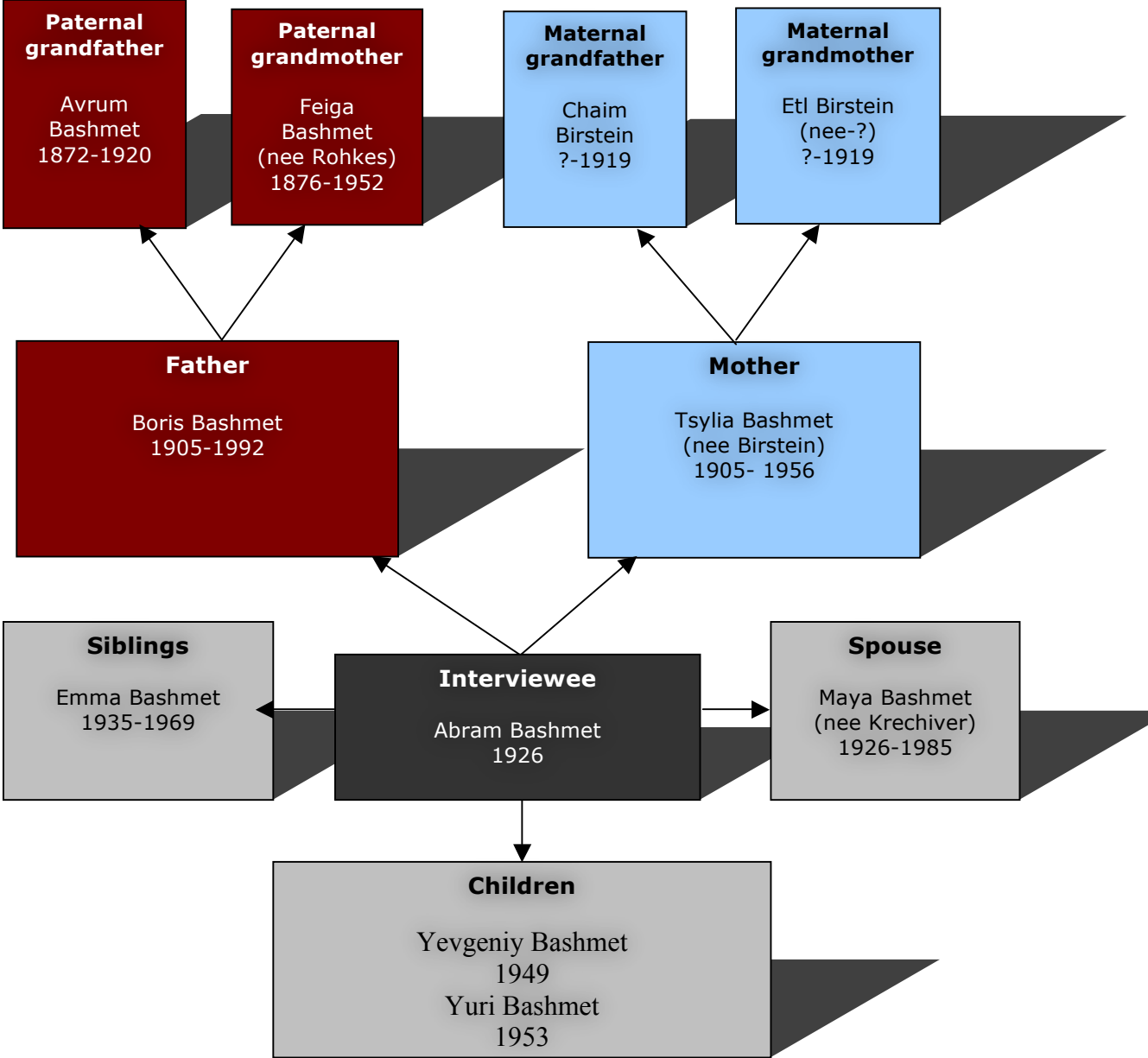

Religious, followed the kashrut, celebrated Saturday and religious holidays, didn't go to the synagogue, covered her head on holidays.
