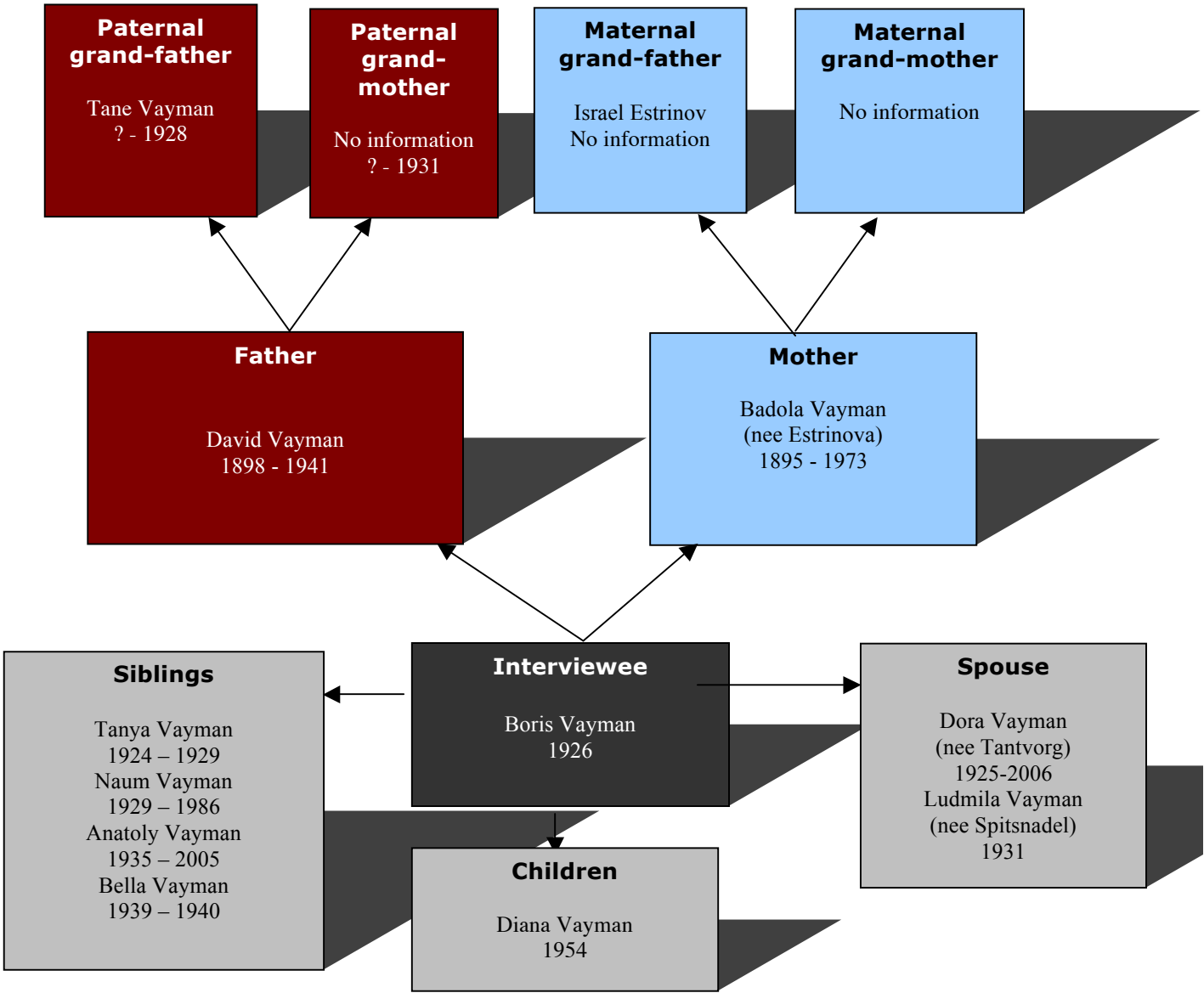

Estrinova Dahsa: born in Kokhanovichi of Vitebsk region (now Belarus), a housewife, was killed by Germans in 1942;

Estrinov Roman: born in 1893, lived in Leningrad, was married, had got a daughter. He worked as a tailor, died in 1980;

Estrinov Konstantin: born in 1902, lived in Leningrad, a tailor, had got a wife and a daughter. Died in 1954.
