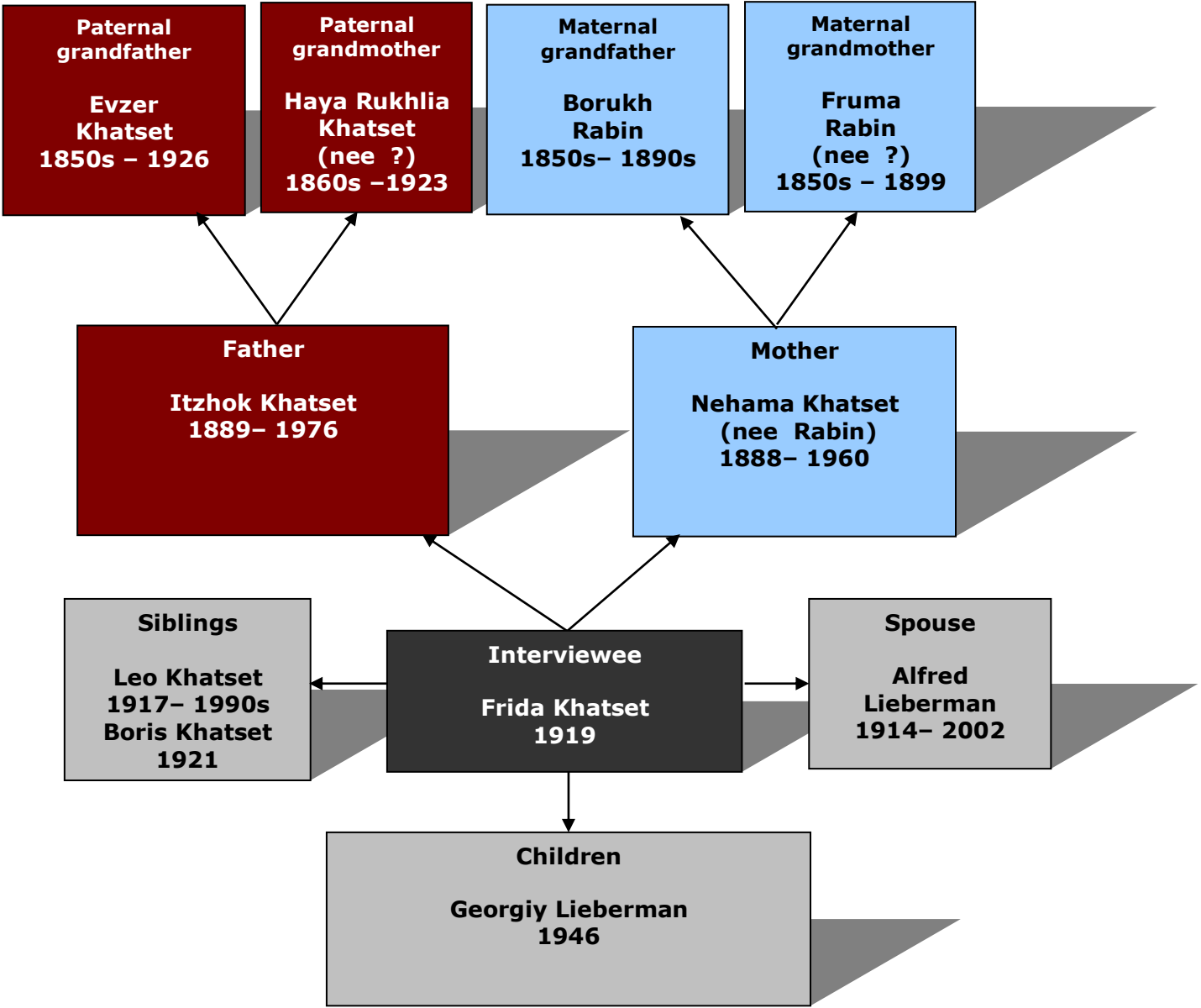

The family celebrated Jewish holidays, lit candles on Friday, when grandfather was alive (before 1926), afterward no traditions were observed in the family

Dunia ? (nee Khatset) (1878 –1941Kiev): born in Kiev, lived in Irpen with her husband (near Kiev), no children, perished in Babi Yar

Gersh Khatset (1883-1945 Gorky, Russia): born in Kiev, graduated from Kiev Industrial Institute, profession: leather specialist, worked as accountant, Lived in Gorky. Wife Nina, daughters: Ira and Tamara,

Manya ? (nee Khatset) (1880 –1950s Moscow): finished Kiev Conservatory, got married and moved to Moscow, no children

Boris Khatset (1890s – 1956 Viatka): born in Kiev, graduated from Kiev Industrial Institute, leather engineer, lived in Viatka, was married, son Karik. Arrested in 1937 — lived in Viatka after was released, remarried, rehabilitated posthumously

Vera Khatset (1902 –1970s Moscow), graduated from Kiev University, chemical engineer, lived in Moscow, single, no children
