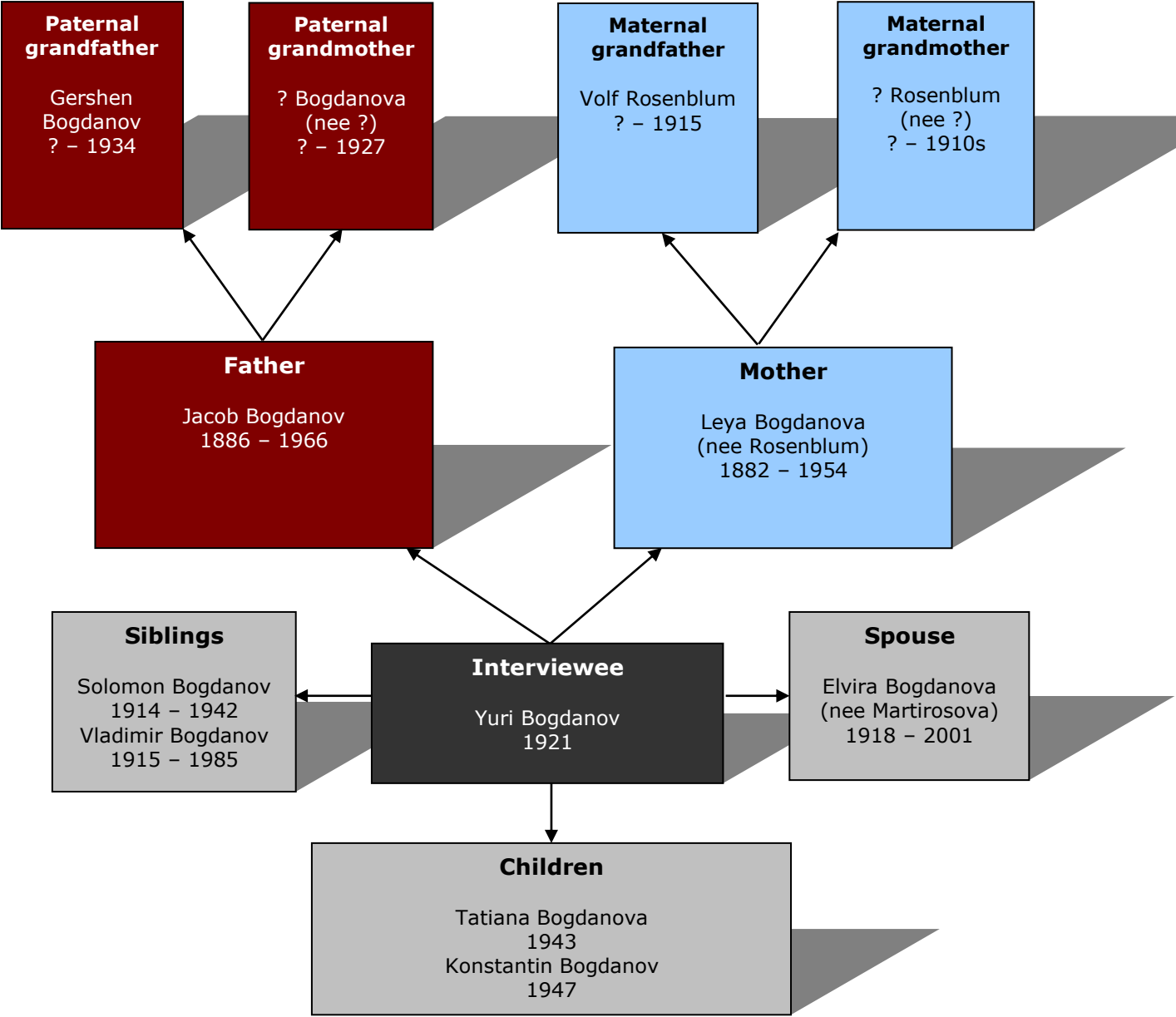


Family Tree

Babruysk (today Belarus), 1921

Where else did you live?

Moscow, Kharkov (today Ukraine), Tokmak, and other military towns all over the territory of the former USSR

Your educational level?

Graduated from Kharkov artillery radar academy, radar department

What sort of work do/did you do?

1952 – 1975: professional soldier, retired as colonel

1975 – 1987: teacher of radar location at Moscow Polytechnic University

How religious was your parents' home? How were you raised?

My parents were religious. They stuck to all Jewish traditions, marked Sabbath, observed the kashrut and Jewish holidays at home. Father went to the synagogue on Sabbath and holidays; Mother went to the synagogue only on holidays. They wore secular clothes, father didn't wear a hat and shaved. Mother wore a kerchief.

Yiddish

Russian, German

1939 – 1941: urgent service in Soviet Army
