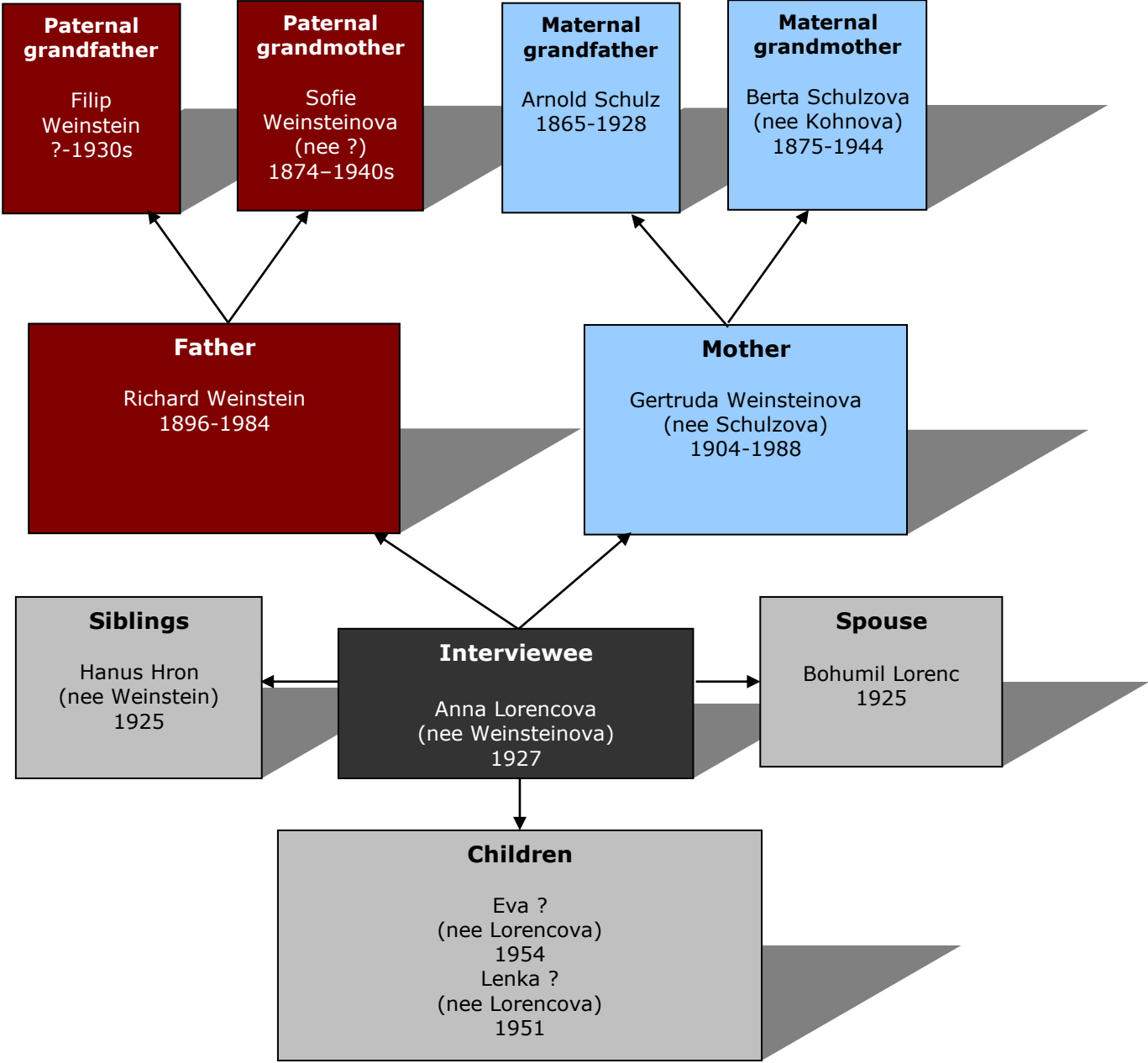

At home we were brought up in the conviction that we were Jews. My parents kept company with Jews. We kept certain traditions, but were probably not as religious as most other Jews in Most or in the rest of Bohemia. We were assimilated and did not stand out from other people in terms of our appearance or way of life. The main holidays we observed and we went to the synagogue, but we didn't have kosher food at home.
